

# Trauma Informed Care

This presentation provides a framework for understanding what can be considered as trauma, as it relates to neurological development. We will also discuss how trauma can alter brain development, and how this manifests in the classroom. The training will provide an overview of one model that explains trauma, the Neurosequential Model of Education, and how the manifestation of undesired behaviors can be understood within the context of this model, as well as discuss the role of the autonomic nervous system, particularly as it relates to our work in the social realm. And, as time allows, we will discuss practical activities and environmental considerations in schools to better aid individuals to overcome the effects of trauma in their own lives.

Dr. Eichler earned his Bachelor degree in Psychology and Human Development and Family Life and his Master's in Human Development from the University of Kansas, with an emphasis in program evaluation. He received his PhD from Holos University. Many will recognize David as the past Director of Project STAY in Northeast Kansas (assessing students who exhibit challenging behaviors). He continues to work as a Behavior Consultant.
